Key Milestone: Transfer Slab Activity Begins in Both Towers

With podium and walkway levels largely complete in the tower area, our attention has now shifted to the **transfer slabs** - a crucial element in any high-rise structure that sets the stage for the typical residential floors to begin.

- Ground/Podium slab completed
- Walkway level slab reinforcement and formwork in progress
- Ground to Walkway level: Columns and core wall concreting ongoing
- Walkway slab to be completed by July-end
- Transfer slab activity to follow

- Transfer level columns and core wall works in progress
- Transfer slab activity to be underway by end of July

What is a Transfer Slab?

A transfer slab is a **heavily reinforced concrete slab** that redistributes loads from the building's columns and walls. It separates the lower levels (such as basements and podiums, which may have different column layouts) from the uniform grid of the residential floors above.

Here's why it matters:

- Structural Transition: Enables a change in column layout to suit the design of parking and amenities below vs. apartments above.
- Engineering Complexity: Often thicker and more reinforced than other slabs, requiring detailed planning.
- Paves the Way: Once cast, the repetitive floor construction (where speed and rhythm accelerate) begins..

We're entering this next stage now - a strong sign that your future home is rising steadily and intelligently.
